

2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design
Signed in to law – Published September 15, 2010

In the 2004 (updated in '07) ADAAG document – there was a wonderful *index* for easy reference. Specific to Play Areas, the index highlighted 12 different section of the 300+ page document:

- ABA Scoping Pages 91, 96, 99 & 136
- ADA Scoping Pages 22, 28, 32, 66 & 67
- Common Technical Pages 274, 275 & 276

Crib Sheet for the 2010 Standard – Play Areas only

There is no index in the 2010 document.

The following is what we have located and feel are critical for Play Areas – if anyone locates another section – drop me a line – it’s a large document!

- Front cover thru page 2 Simple Introduction with Table of Contents
 - The TOC is general – the one page overview is quite succinct
- Page 3 – Page 14 Title II – State and Local Government Facilities
 - There are variances in scoping between Titles II and II – this highlights several of the differences. Provides reference dates for compliance for Title II facilities
- Page 15 – Page 30 Title III – Public Accommodations
 - There are variances in scoping between Titles II and II – this highlights several of the differences. Provides reference dates for compliance for Tile III facilities
- Pages 31 – Page 252 Title II and II Facilities
 - These sections contain all of the technical data that you need (for Play Areas)
 - Note: This information is verbatim to the 2004 ADAAG

 - Page 42 See definition Children’s Use
